AN ORDER ALLOWING THE PARTICIPATION OF ALL LEARNERS REGARDLESS OF COVID-19 VACCINATION STATUS, IN THE FACE-TO-FACE CLASSES IN SCHOOLS WITHIN THE CITY OF MALOLOS

WHEREAS, on October 18, 2021, the Department of Education issued DepEd Memorandum No. 071, s. 2021 entitled Preparations for the Pilot Face-to-Face Classes, Expansion and Transitioning to New Normal;

WHEREAS, on April 6, 2022, Department of Education issued DepEd Order No. 017, s. 2022 providing the Guidelines On The Progressive Expansion Of Face To Face classes;

WHEREAS, the Department of Education and the Department of Health issued on April 6, 2022 Joint Memorandum Circular No. 001, s. 2022, or the Revised Operational Guidelines On The Progressive Expansion of Face to Face Learning Modality, providing among others, that all learners may participate in the face-to-face classes regardless of COVID-19 vaccination status;

WHEREAS, notwithstanding the aggressive information dissemination and vaccination drive of the government, vaccination hesitancy among Filipinos, especially the parents, remained prevalent;

WHERAS, Sec. 15, Art. II of the 1987 Constitution provides that: "The State shall protect and promote the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among them.";

WHEREAS, COVID-19 vaccination remains voluntary as there is a need to respect the peoples' constitutional right to health;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, CHRISTIAN D. NATIVIDAD, Mayor of the City of Malolos, Bulacan, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order that:

SECTION 1. PARTICIPATION IN FACE-TO-FACE CLASSES. All school aged children enrolled in the public or private school in the City of Malolos, can participate in the face-to-face classes regardless of COVID-19 vaccination status.

SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH MINIMUM HEALTH PROTOCOLS. All school heads are enjoined to ensure compliance with the Revised Operational Guidelines on the Progressive Expansion of Face-to-Face Learning Modality, as contained in Joint Memorandum Circular No. 001, s. 2022, issued by the Department of Education and the Department of Health.

SECTION 3. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If any provision of this Executive Order is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the other provisions not affected thereby shall remain valid and subsisting.

SECTION 4. REPEALING CLAUSE. All Orders or parts thereof which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Executive Order are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.
