WHEREAS, the World Health Organization (WHO) declared on January 2020 the outbreak of the novel coronavirus which was later identified as COVID-19.

WHEREAS, Proclamation No. 929, s. 2020, issued on 16 March 2020, such placed the entire Philippines under the State of Calamity in the country for six (6) months.

WHEREAS, on 24 April 2020, the Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG) issued Memorandum Circular No. 2020-077 calling for the establishment of the respective local government unit task force against COVID-19.

WHEREAS, in order to provide a more localized response to the COVID-19 situation in the City of Malolos, there is a need to organize the Local COVID-19 Task Force.

SECTION I. CREATION OF THE MALOLOS CITY COVID-19 TASK FORCE (MCCTF). The Malolos City COVID-19 Task Force (MCCTF) is hereby organized in accordance with the DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2020-077 wherein the City Mayor shall be the Chairperson.

SECTION IV. REPEALING CLAUSE. All orders, issuances, memoranda or any part thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Order are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

SECTION V. DISSEMINATION. Let a copy of this Order be sent to the Office of the Provincial Governor pursuant to Sec. 455 (b)(1)(xii) of Chapter III Art. I of R.A. 7160 known as the "Local Government Code of 1991", the City Mayor shall furnish copies of executive orders issued by him, to the provincial governor within seventy-two (72) hours after their issuances.

SECTION VI. EFFECTIVITY. This Order shall take effect immediately upon signing.
