**EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 01. SERIES 2019**

## **AN ORDER RE-ORGANIZING THE CREATION OF THE CITY PEACE AND ORDER COUNCIL (CPOC)**

**WHEREAS**, SEC. 116 of the Local Government Code states that there is hereby established in every province, city and municipality a local peace and order council;

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Executive Order Numbered Three hundred nine (E.O. No. 309), Series of 1988, the Local Peace and Order Councils shall have the same composition and functions as those prescribed by the said executive order;

**WHEREAS**, it is the duty of every local government unit (LGU) to assist the National Government to effectively prevent and suppress criminality and maintain public safety and order;

**WHEREAS**, the participation of citizenry in the maintenance of peace and order is of crucial importance;

**NOW THEREFORE, I, ATTY. CHRISTIAN D. NATIVIDAD**, City Mayor of City of Malolos, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the following:

**SECTION 1.** Re-organization of the City Peace and Order Council (CPOC) as provided in Executive Order 773 s. of 2009 and City Government of Malolos Executive Order No. 01. S. 2017 as amended to be composed of the following:

**SECTION 2. DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS.** The City Peace and Order Council (CPOC) shall be responsible for the proper management and supervision of civilian volunteer organization in coordination with other appropriate government entities. The CPOC shall perform the following duties and functions:


- a) Provide a forum for dialogue and deliberation of major issues and problems affecting peace and order, including insurgency;
- b) Recommend measures which will improve or enhance peace and order and public safety in their respective areas of responsibility, including insurgency measures;
- c) Recommend measures to converge and orchestrate internal security operation efforts of civil authorities and agencies, military and police;
- d) Recommend sanctions against local chief executives who are giving material and political support to the Communist rebels;
- e) Monitor the provision of livelihood and infrastructure development programs and projects in the remote rural and indigenous population areas adopted to isolate them from the Communist rebels' "Agitate/Arouse, Organize and Mobilize" and ideological, political and organization works;
- f) Perform all other functions assigned by law, the President or the National Peace and Order Council (NPOC).

The Civilian Volunteer Organizations (CVOs) shall be managed and supervised by the City Director of the PNP.

**SECTION 3. CITY PEACE AND ORDER COUNCIL SECRETARIAT.** The City Local Government Operations Officer of DILG assigned in the city shall act as the head of the CPOC Secretariat which shall handle the administrative, operational and technical activities of the CPOC. The Secretariat shall also undertake liaising and coordination of activities with appropriate agencies of the government.

**SECTION 4. EFFECTIVITY.** The reorganized City Peace and Order Council as herein provided shall take effect immediately upon signing.
