EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 05, S. OF 2019

AN ORDER RECONSTITUTING THE CITY SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT BOARD

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the State to protect and advance the right of the people to a balanced and healthful ecology in accord with the rhythm and harmony of nature;

WHEREAS, the Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000 declared as policy of the State to adopt a systematic, comprehensive and ecological solid waste management program;

WHEREAS, the City of Malolos has therefore exerted full effort in setting guidelines and targets for solid waste and the reduction of the same and in the adoption of the best environmental practice in ecological waste management;

WHEREAS, the City Government of Malolos in compliance with DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2004 – 151 mandates the necessity to keep the membership of the City Solid Waste Management Board updated;

WHEREAS, City Solid Waste Management Board was reorganized through Executive Order No. 11. Series of 2017, dated May 2, 2017;

NOW THEREFORE, I, CHRISTIAN D. NATIVIDAD, Local Chief Executive of the City of Malolos in the Province of Bulacan, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the reconstitution of the City Solid Waste Management Board (CSWMB) with the following provisions:

SECTION I. Composition of the CSWMB

SECTION II. Functions of the CSWMB

The City Solid Waste Management Boards shall exercise all duties and responsibilities enumerated in Republic Act 9003, known as Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000.

- (1) Develop the City Solid Waste Management Plan that shall ensure the long-term management of solid waste, as well as integrate the various solid waste management plans and strategies of the barangays in its area of jurisdiction. In the development of the Solid Waste Management Plan, it shall conduct consultations with the various sectors of the community;
- (2) Adopt measures to promote and ensure the viability and effective implementation of solid waste management programs in its component barangays;
- (3) Monitor the implementation of the City Solid Waste Management Plan through its various political subdivisions and in cooperation with the private sector and the NGOs;

- (4) Adopt specific revenue-generating measures to promote the viability of its Solid Waste Management Plan;
- (5) Convene regular meetings for purposes of planning and coordinating the implementation of the solid waste management plans of the respective component barangays;
- (6) Oversee the implementation of the City Solid Waste Management Plan;
- (7) Review every two (2) years or as the need arises the City Solid Waste Management Plan for purposes of ensuring its sustainability, viability, effectiveness and relevance in relation to local and international developments in the field of solid waste management;
- (8) Develop the specific mechanics and guidelines for the implementation of the City Solid Waste Management Plan;
- (9) Recommended to appropriate local government authorities' specific measures or proposals for franchise or build-operate-transfer agreements with duly recognized institutions, pursuant to R.A.6957, to provide either exclusive or non-exclusive authority for the collection, transfer, storage, processing, recycling or disposal of city solid waste. The proposals shall take into consideration appropriate government rules and regulations on contracts, franchise and build-operate-transfer agreements;
- (10) Provide the necessary logistical and operational support to its component cities and municipalities in consonance with subsection (f) of Sec. 17 of the Local Government Code;
- (11) Recommended measures and safeguards against pollution and for the preservation of the natural ecosystem; and
- (12) Coordinates the efforts of its components barangays in the implementation of the City Solid Waste Management Plan.

SECTION III. The Technical Working Group

The Technical Working Group shall be under the supervision of the City Environment and Natural Resources Office. The Environment Specialist shall spearhead the implementation of the actions decided upon by the CSWMB on collecting, disposal, and management of solid wastes in the city.

The members of the Technical Working Group shall be decided upon by the CSWMB during its initial meeting to be called by the Chairman or Co-Chairman.

SECTION IV. Effectivity

This Executive Order shall take effect immediately upon its signing.
