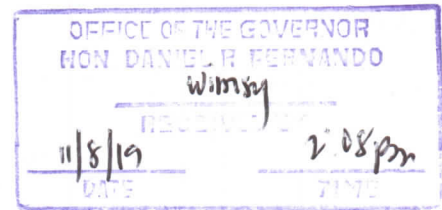

Executive Order No. 21 s. 2019

AN ORDER RECONSTITUTING THE LOCAL HEALTH BOARD OF THE CITY OF MALOLOS IDENTIFYING ITS MEMBERS, THEIR DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS AND OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, Article XIII Section 11 of 1987 Philippine Constitution prescribed that the State shall adopt an integrated and comprehensive approach to health development which shall endeavor to make essential goods, health and other social services available to all the people at affordable cost;

WHEREAS, Section 102 of the Local Government Code of 1991 mandated the creation of local health boards and defined its composition and functions;

WHEREAS, the Local Chief Executive affirmed to the people of the city better quality of health services;

NOW, THEREFORE, I ENGR. GILBERT T. GATCHALIAN, City Mayor of Malolos, Bulacan, by virtue of powers vested in me by existing and applicable laws do hereby order the following:

Section 1. Composition. The Local Health Board is composed of:

Chairperson	:	City Mayor
Vice Chairperson	:	City Health Officer
Members:	:	Sangguniang Panlungsod Chairperson, Committee on Health Representative from private/non-government organizations involved in health services Representative of Department of Health in the City

Section 2. Functions of Local Health Board.

1. To propose to the Sangguniang Panlungsod, in accordance with standards and criteria set by the Department of Health, annual budgetary allocations for the operation and maintenance of health facilities and services;

2. To serve as an advisory committee to the Sangguniang Panlungsod concerned on health matters such as, but not limited to, the necessity for, and application of local appropriations for public health purposes;
3. Consistent with the technical and administrative standards of the Department of Health, create committees which shall advise local health agencies on matters such as, but not limited to, personnel selection and promotion, bids and awards, grievance and complaints, personnel discipline, budget review, operations review and similar functions.

Section 3. Meetings and Quorum.

1. The board shall meet at least once a month or as may be necessary.
2. A majority of the members of the board shall constitute a quorum, but the Chairperson or the Vice Chairperson must be present during meetings where budgetary proposals are being prepared or considered. The affirmative vote of all the majority of the members shall be necessary to approve such proposals.

Section 4. Secretariat. The board shall designate a secretariat to support the implementation of this order.

Section 5. Effectivity. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately upon signing.
