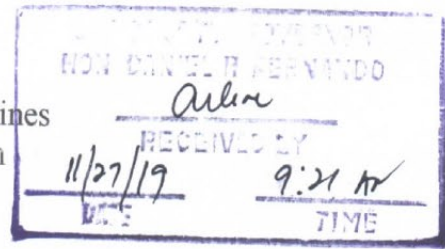

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 30 . SERIES OF 2019

AN ORDER CREATING THE NEW TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP ANENT FINAL DRAFTING OF THE REVISED TRAFFIC CODE OF THE CITY OF MALOLOS AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City Ordinance No. 15-2001, otherwise known as The Traffic Code of the Municipality of Malolos is in existence, more or less, for nineteen (19) years;

WHEREAS, in the said span of years, our locality is experiencing dynamic commercial activities;

WHEREAS, from the said experience, many commercial and industrial edifices were established and continuing cropping out;

WHEREAS, the City of Malolos has also experienced an influx of immigrant coming from nearby provinces particularly from Pampanga and Metro Manila that led to the mushrooming of residential villages and subdivisions;

WHEREAS, the City of Malolos being the center of education in the province has a huge population of students coming from nearby town or even provinces and still growing every year;

WHEREAS, economic growth also produces traffic problems and if could not be resolved would throw our economy back twenty years later;

WHEREAS, it clearly manifested that the existing traffic ordinance is no longer suited to the present traffic condition of the locality and that there is a necessity to revisit, review and modify the existing ordinance;

NOW THEREFORE, I, GILBERT T. GATCHALIAN, Chief Executive of the City of Malolos, by virtue of the power vested in me by law, do hereby order the following:

BRIEF EXPLANATION ON STUDY:

- Household Population 10 Years Old and Over by Age Group and Sex: 2000
- Figures are estimates based on a 10% sample) = 134,000 = 170,680 passengers 10 yo above for 2019 (1.41% AGR)
- 170,680 + 36,478 pre-school and elem students below 10 yo passengers (2016 data) = 207,158 passengers
- No. of schools by level = 217 with 112,935 students + 1,499 teachers = 114,434 in-school passengers (2016 data)
- No. of establishments= 3,431 (5 year average)
- Labor Force = 164,483 (40% from other municipalities) = 65,793 passengers from different municipalities
- No. of population from other municipalities doing business in the City of Malolos (tourists, business sectors, etc.) = 30,000
- 207,158 passengers from the City of Malolos + 65,793 passengers labor force from other = 309,416 passengers/day (70% of estimated no. of passengers population riding in tricycle)
- 309,416 passengers population/day or estimated 605,902 trips/driver x Php22.00 = Php1,936,000 to Php2,640,000 (88 trips x 10 mins. Ave./trip = 14 hours = cannot be accommodated)
- 605,902 trips/13,810 (Colorum=6,979 and legal TODA=6,831) = 44 trips x Php22.00 = Php968,000/driver to Php1,320,000 (44 trips x 10 mins. Ave./trip = 7 hours)

REMARKS: For Zone 1, an average of 82 trips per TODA member per day or equivalent to Php1,804.00 to P2,460.00 gross income/day but due to colorums mostly private tricycles pretending as school service the same the number of tricycles with franchise (100% or 1,745 units), the gross will reduced by 30-50% (Php832.00-1,248.00). If the government will give franchise of additional 1,745 units, each TODA will only earn Php902.00 to Php1,230.00 gross income for 41 trips (Php22.00-Php30.00 fare/trip) each TODA per day. (41 trips x 10 mins/trip = 7 hours)

If the government will give franchise to additional 1,900 units, each TODA can earn Php924.00 to Php1,260.00 gross income for 42 trips (Php22.00-Php30.00 fare/trip) each TODA per day. (42 trips x 10 mins/trip = 7 hours)

If the government will give franchise to additional 1,621 units, each TODA can earn Php1,038.00 to Php1,410.00 gross income for 47 trips (Php22.00-Php30.00 fare/trip) each TODA per day. (47 trips x 10 mins/trip = 8 hours).


REMARKS: For Zone 4, an average of 92 trips per TODA member per day or equivalent to Php2,024.00 gross income/day but due to colorums mostly RCMBO tricycles (tricycles with terminals in every corner, along McArthur Highway, from Paombong, Calumpit and Hagonoy) almost the same number of tricycles with franchise (100% or 1,734 units), the gross will be reduced by 40-50% (Php810.00-1,012.00). If the government will give franchise to additional 1,734 units except for those from other municipalities, each TODA will only earn Php1,012.00 to Php1,380.00 gross income for 46 trips (Php22.00-Php30.00 fare/trip) per day. (46 trips x 10 mins/trip = 7.5 hours).

SPECIAL NOTE: 6,831 TODA with franchise + needed/ additional franchise of 2,732 = 9,563 TODA distributed to estimated 606,000 trips for 70% of estimated passengers population/day = 63 trips/TODA @ Php22.30/trip = Php1,386 to Php1,890 gross income/day or total of Php13,332,000.00 to Php18,000,000 gross income/day of tricycle transport business.
