EXECUTVE ORDER NO.34

AN ORDER ENJOINING THE RECONSTITUTION OF THE CITY DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT COUNCIL (CDRRMC) IN THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF MALOLOS.

WHEREAS, the City Government of Bulacan staunchly adheres to the Constitutional mandate that prime duty of the government is to serve and protect the people as enshrined in Article II, Section 4 thereof;

WHEREAS, in pursuit of the above stated principle, it is the duty of local government to protect its people not only from the dangers and threats brought about by the advancement of society. But most significantly to protect them from the immeasurable risks generated by climate change and extreme weather conditions and reduce its harmful effects through comprehensive planning and risk reduction methods;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections 324 (d) and 444, Par. B (viii) of Republic act No. 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, as amended by Republic Act No. 8185, Local Government Units shall adopt measures to protect its inhabitants from harmful effects of man-made or natural calamities and to provide relief services and assistance to victims during and in the aftermath of disaster and in their return to productive livelihood;

WHEREAS, Republic Act no. 10121 or the Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2010 "An Act Strengthening the Philippine Risk Reduction and Management (DRRM) System, Providing for the National DRRM Framework and institutionalizing the National DRRM Plan, Appropriating Funds Therefore and for Other Purposes" was signed into law on 27 May 2010 and a corresponding Implementing Rules and Regulations was duly promulgated on 27 September 2010;

WHEREAS, Paragraph (a), Section 2 of the same law declares that the states shall uphold the people's constitutional right to life and property by addressing the root causes of vulnerabilities to disasters, strengthening the country's institutional capacity for disaster risk reduction and

reduction and management and building the resilience of local communities to disasters including climate change impacts;

WHEREAS, consonant with Paragraph (f), Section 2 of R.A. No. 10121, the City Government of Malolos shall adopt and implement a coherent, comprehensive, integrated, efficient and responsive disaster risk reduction program incorporated in its development plan adhering to the principles of good governance such as transparency and accountability within the context of poverty alleviation and environmental protection;

WHEREAS, Section 11 of the same act establishes a Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (CDRMMC) which shall be responsible to approve, monitor and evaluate the implementation of the LDRRMPs and regularly review and test the plan consistent with other national and local planning programs and ensure the integration of disaster risk reduction and climate change adaptation into local development plans, programs and budgets as a strategy in sustainable development and poverty reduction;

NOW THEREFORE, I, GILBERT T. GATCHALIAN, City Mayor of Malolos, Bulacan, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law do hereby order the reconstitution of the City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (CDRRMC) in the City Government of Malolos with the following provisions:

Section 1. Reconstituted City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council

The reorganized CDRRMC shall be composed of the following to wit:

Section 2. Functions and Responsibilities.

The CDRRMC shall discharge and perform the following functions in relation to the provision of Republic Act 10121 and other pertinent laws:

- a. Approve, monitor and evaluate the implementation of the LDRRMPs and regularly review and test the plan consistent with other national and local planning programs;
- b. Ensure the integration of disaster risk reduction and climate change adaptation into local development plans, programs and budgets as a strategy in sustainable development and poverty reduction;

- c. Recommend the implementation of forced or preemptive evacuation of local residents, if necessary; and
- d. Convene the local council once every three (3) months or as necessary.

Section 3. Repealing Clause.

All other issuances or parts thereof that are consistent with this executive order are hereby repealed or modifies accordingly.

Section 4. Repealing Clause.

If any part of the this executive order is held invalid or unconstitutional by any incompetent court, the other parts or provisions not affected shall remain valid.

Section 5. Effectivity.

This executive order shall take effect immediately upon signing.
