AN EXECUTIVE ORDER PROVIDING GUIDELINES ON THE RESUMPTION OF OPERATIONS OF PUBLIC UTILITY TRICYCLES DURING THE MODIFIED ENHANCED COMMUNITY QUARANTINE.

WHEREAS, on 16 May 2020, the National Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Disease placed the entire Province of Bulacan under Modified Enhanced Community Quarantine;

WHEREAS, pursuant to paragraph 2 of Section 13 of the Executive Order No. 18 of the Honorable Governor Daniel R. Fernando provides that "Operation of public utility tricycles may be allowed by cities and municipalities, subject to the one-passenger limit without a backrider, and in accordance with Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) guidelines."

WHEREAS, the letter dated 25 May 2020 from the Department of the Interior and Local Government Region Director Julie J. Daquioag, Ph.d., CESO III to the President of the League of Municipalities of the Philippines – Bulacan Chapter – Hon. Ambrosio C. Cruz, Jr confirmed that the Undersecretary of Operations of the DILG – Usec. Epimaco V. Densing III clarified that the operations of tricycles as means of public transport in MECQ areas fall within the discretion of the Local Chief Executives;

WHEREAS, transportation is a necessity to the Malolenyos, especially the frontliners, during this time of pandemic;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 455, (2) (iii) of the Local Government Code of 1991, the City Mayor as the Chief Executive of the city government has the power to issue such executive orders for the faithful and appropriate enforcement and execution of laws and ordinances;

NOW THEREFORE, I, ENGR. GILBERT T. GATCHALIAN, City Mayor of the City of Malolos, Bulacan, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order:

SECTION I. RESUMPTION OF OPERATIONS OF PUBLIC UTILITY TRICYCLE. Public utility tricycles whose owners or operators are members of Federation of Tricycle Operators and Drivers Association of Malolos City Bulacan Inc. are now allowed to operate.

SECTION II. ODD-EVEN SCHEME. Public utility tricycles shall follow the odd-even scheme below:

DAYS	LAST DIGIT OF BODY NUMBER
Monday, Wednesday, Friday	1,3,5,7,9
Tuesday, Thursday, Saturday	0,2,4,6,8

SECTION III. OPERATING HOURS. Public utility tricycles are allowed to operate from 5AM until 7PM.

SECTION IV. SAFETY PROTOCOLS. Tricycle drivers shall observe the following measures:

1. A separator, be it in plastic or cloth material, shall be installed between the driver and the passenger inside the sidecar of the tricycle;
2. Only one passenger is allowed inside the tricycle. There shall be no backriders at any given instance;
3. Drivers shall wear facemask, goggles or any eye protection, and gloves; and
4. All drivers shall disinfect their vehicles, especially the surfaces oftentimes touched by the passengers.

SECTION VI. EFFECTIVITY. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately upon signing thereof.
