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Executive Order No. 35 s. 2021

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AN EXECUTIVE ORDER ORGANIZING THE CITY OF MALOLOS DEVOLUTION TRANSITION COMMITTEE (CMDTC)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 2 (a) of Republic Act (RA) No. 7160 or the Local Government Code of 1991 (LGC), the State shall provide for a more responsive and accountable local government structure instituted through a system of decentralization whereby local government units (LGUs) shall be given more powers, authority, responsibilities, and resources;

WHEREAS, section 3 (d) of RA No. 7160 further provides that the vesting of duty, responsibility, and accountability in LGUs shall be accompanied with provision for reasonably adequate resources to discharge their powers and effectively carry out their functions; hence, they shall have the power to create and broaden their own sources of revenue and the right to a just share in national taxes and an equitable share in the proceeds of the utilization and development of the national wealth within their respective areas;

WHEREAS, Local Government Units are primarily responsible for providing direct service delivery to their constituencies and will assume greater responsibility and accountability in ensuring the quality of devolved services;

WHEREAS, Local Government Units are expected to strengthen their capacity to exercise stewardship of their increased fiscal resources; enhance their organizational capability for service delivery; and institute transparent, accountable, and participatory mechanisms to better achieve national and local development objectives;

WHEREAS, Local Government Units are encouraged to establish robust partnership with national government agencies (NGAs), private sector, non-government organizations (NGOs), civil society organizations (CSOs), peoples' organizations (POs), and academic institutions as providers of technical expertise and information, innovations, and governance models on service delivery;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, GILBERT T. GATCHALIAN, City Mayor of Malolos, Bulacan, by virtue of the power vested in me by existing and applicable laws do hereby order the:

FUNCTIONS AND DUTIES. The TWG shall perform the following:

- 1. Identify the functions, services, and facilities to be fully assumed and programs, projects and activities (PPAs) to be devolved by NGAs concerned;
- 2. Prioritize which of these needs scaling-up;

3. Adopt a phased approach, from FY 2022-2024, toward full assumption of these devolved responsibilities; .

4. Make modifications on the organizational structure and competency requirements, that will consequently entail updating of the Organizational Structure and Staffing Pattern (OSSP) and Capacity Development (CapDev) Agenda;

5. Prepare an addendum to the City of Malolos OSSP for additional personnel

complement;

6. Formulate Local Revenue Forecast and Resource Mobilization Strategy (FYs 2022-2024); and

7. Play a differentiated role by performing oversight functions over barangays within the City of Malolos.

SECTION 3. SECRETARIAT. The City Planning and Development Coordinator shall head the secretariat of the CMDTC responsible for providing technical and administrative support, documenting proceedings, preparing reports, and providing such other assistance as may be required by the CMDTC.

This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
