PAGTATAKDA NG MGA PANUNTUNANG IPATUTUPAD SA LUNGSOD NG MALOLOS MULA IKA-4 NG AGOSTO HANGGANG SA ANG KLASIPIKASYONG PANGKUWARENTINANG *MODIFIED ENHANCED COMMUNITY QUARANTINE (MECQ)* AY MABAGO.

SAPAGKAT, alinsunod sa deklarasyon ng Pangulo ng Republika ng Pilipinas noong 2 Agosto 2020, batay sa rekomendasyon ng Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases, ang Lalawigan ng Bulacan ay muling isinailalim sa klasipikasyong pangkuwarentinang Modified Enhanced Community Quarantine;

SAPAGKAT, alinsunod sa Seksyon 15 Artikulo II ng Konstitusyon ng Republika ng Pilipinas 1987, dapat itaguyod at pangalagaan ng Estado ang karapatan sa kalusugan ng mga mamamayan at ikintal ang kamalayang kalusugan sa kanila;

SAPAGKAT, alinsunod sa Seksyon 16 ng Kodigo ng Pamahalaang Lokal ng Pilipinas 1991, nararapat na siguraduhin at suportahan ng mga pamahalaang lokal ang kalusugan at kaligtasan ng kanilang mamamayan bilang bahagi ng pangkalahatang kapakanan sa kani-kanilang nasasakupan;

SAPAGKAT, alinsunod sa Seksyon 455 (2) (iii) ng Kodigo ng Pamahalaang Lokal ng 1991, ang Punong Lungsod bilang Punong Tagapagpaganap ng pamahalaang lungsod ay may kapangyarihang mag-akda ng mga atas tagapagpaganap para sa taimtim na pagsasagawa ng mga batas at ordinansa;

NGAYON, SAMAKATUWID, ako, si **INH. GILBERT T. GATCHALIAN**, Punong Lungsod ng Lungsod ng Malolos, Lalawigan ng Bulacan, sa bisa ng kapangyarihang kaloob sa akin ng mga umiiral na batas, ay ipinag-uutos ang mga sumusunod:

SEKSYON I. MULING PAGPAPATUPAD NG TWO-DAY WINDOW PERIOD AT NG PAGGAMIT NG HOME QUARANTINE PASS. Upang mapaigting ang pag-iingat sa mga Malolenyo sa pamamagitan ng paglilimita ng paglabas ng bahay, muling ipatutupad ang two-day window period at ang paggamit ng home quarantine pass.

Bilang gabay ng lahat, lakip ng Atas na ito bilang Annex I ang clustering ng mga barangay na ating ipinatupad mula noong panahon ng ECQ at muling ipatutupad ngayong ang Lungsod ay nasa ilalim ng MECQ mula ika-4 na Agosto 2020 hanggang sa ang klasipikasyong pangkuwarentina ng Lungsod ay mabago.

Bukod sa mga Authorized Persons Outside Residences, isa lamang sa bawat bahay ang pahihintulutang makalabas ayon sa two-day window period upang makabili o makapagsagawa ng transaksyon sa mga establisyimentong pinahihintulutang magbukas.

Ang lahat ng establisyimentong may pahintulot na magbukas ay muling tinatagubiling tanging ang mga APOR at mga residente ng Lungsod ng Malolos na napagkalooban ng home quarantine pass lamang ang maaaring papasukin sa kanilang mga establisyimento. Magkagayunman, ang mga bangko, ospital, klinika, at tanggapan ng gobyerno ay maaaring tumanggap ng mga hindi residente ng Malolos na makapagpapakita ng quarantine pass mula sa kanilang Pamahalaang Bayan o Pamahalaang Lungsod o ng travel authority mula sa awtorisadong kinatawan ng Philippine National Police.

SEKSYON I.1 MGA AUTHORIZED PERSON OUTSIDE RESIDENCES (APOR).

Ang mga APOR ay ang mga sumusunod:

1. Frontliners at healthworkers;
2. Mga opisyal at kawani ng mga ahensiya ng Pamahalaan;
3. Mga manggagawa/manininda ng mga establisyimentong may pahintulot nang magbukas;
4. Mga Opisyal at kawani ng mga foreign diplomatic missions and international organizations;
5. Mga Pastor, Pari, Imam at iba pang ministrong pang-relihiyon kaugnay sa kanilang pagsasagawa ng funeral rites;
6. Mga nagbabalik na Overseas Filipino Workers, sa araw na itinalagang kanilang pag-uwi sa Lungsod ng Malolos;
7. Mga indibidwal na may edad 21-59, na hindi kasama sa mga nabanggit, na napagkalooban ng quarantine pass.

SEKSIYON I.2 Sa lahat ng pagkakataon, ang mga may pahintulot na lumabas ay nararapat na magsuot ng face mask at sumunod sa mga ipinatutupad na panuntunin patungkol sa physical distancing.

SEKSYON I.3 FRONTLINER'S SUNDAY. Bilang pagpapahalaga sa dedikasyon ng mga frontliners tungo sa pagpapabuti ng kalusugan ng mga coronavirus patients, inilalaan ang araw ng Linggo para sa mga Frontliners. Tanging ang mga frontliners ang pahihintulutang makapasok sa mga establisyimento tuwing araw ng Linggo.

SEKSYON II. MAHIGPIT NA PAGRE-REPORT SA MGA BARANGAY OFFICIALS NG LAHAT NG BALIKBAYAN AT MGA MALOLENYONG NAGBALIK MULA SA IBANG BAYAN. Lahat ng Balikbayan, mga Malolenyong nagbalik mula sa ibang bayan, at mga Malolenyong stranded sa ibang bayan na nagbalik sa Lungsod ay inaatasang

makipag-ugnayan sa pamahalaang barangay na nakasasakop na kanilang tirahan upang masiguro ang pagtupad sa *14-day quarantine protocol*.

SEKSYON II.1 Ang lahat ng Balikbayan o OFW na magbabalik sa Lungsod ng Malolos ay nararapat na makapagpakita ng quarantine clearance at medical certificate bago makapasok sa Lungsod. Magkagayunman, sila ay isasailalim pa rin sa 14-day home quarantine sa kanilang pagdating sa Lungsod.

SEKSYON II.2 Ang lahat ng Malolenyo na naipit sa ibang lugar ngayong panahon ng community quarantine o mga *locally stranded individuals*, alinsunod sa National Task Force Against COVID-19 Order No. 2020 – 02, ay nararapat na kumuha ng medical certificate sa Municipal Health Officer o City Health Officer ng bayan o lungsod kung saan sila ay stranded; at ng travel authority mula sa awtorisadong kinatawan ng Philippine National Police.

SEKSYON III. REGULASYON PATUNGKOL SA MGA PAMPUBLIKONG TRANSPORTASYON. Tanging ang mga public utility tricycle lamang at mga Point-to-Point Buses ang pinahihintulutang sasakyang pampasada ngayong panahon ng MECQ. Sa lahat ng pagkakataon, isang tao lamang ang maaaring maging pasahero ng tricycle. Samantalang, hanggang kalahati lamang ng kapasidad ng Point-to-Point Buses maaaring sumakay sa Point-to-Point.

SEKSYON III.1 PAMANTAYANG PANGKALUSUGAN. Ang mga tsuper ng pampublikong transportasyon ay kinakailangang sundin ang mga sumusunod:

1. Ang pagsusuot ng face mask, goggles o anumang proteksyon sa mata at gloves sa lahat ng oras;
2. No facemask, no ride policy. Tanging mga may face mask lamang ang maaaring pasakayin sa mga pampublikong sasakyan;
3. Maglagay ng pisikal na harang sa pagitan ng motor at sidecar;
4. Para sa mga Point-to-Point Buses, sundin ang sapat na pagitan ng mga pasahero batay sa guidelines ng DOTr.
5. Magsagawa ng kinakailangang paglilinis o disinfection sa pagitan ng pamamasada o kaya’y habang nasa terminal sa mga parte ng sasakyan na laging nahahawakan, gaya ngunit hindi lamang, ng upuan, tagiliran, patungan ng kamay or armrest at salalayan ng gamit; at
6. Ang Pagkuha ng temperature ng mga mananakay gamit ang mga thermal scanner ay nararapat na isagawa sa lahat ng terminal ng pampublikong sasakyan.

SEKSYON III.2 Ang Fare Matrix ay dapat na nakapaskil sa loob ng bawat traysikel.

SEKSYON III.3 ODD EVEN SCHEME PARA SA MGA TRAYSIKEL. Ang mga pampublikong traysikel ay susunod sa odd-even scheme base sa huling numero ng body number ng traysikel:

SEKSYON IV. MGA ESTABLISYIMENTO / INDUSTRIYA NA PINAHIHINTULUTANG MAGBUKAS NGAYONG MECQ. Lakip ng Atas na ito bilang Annex II, ang Annex A ng Memorandum Circular No. 20-44 Series of 2020 ng Department of Trade and Industry na naglalahad ng mga establisyimentong may pahintulot na magbukas ngayong MECQ. Makikita sa nasabing tala maging ang porsiyento ng operational capacity na pinapayagan.

SEKSYON IV.1 MGA ESTABLISYIMENTO / INDUSTRIYA NA HINDI PINAHIHINTULUTANG MAGBUKAS NGAYONG MECQ. Bilang gabay, ang mga sumusunod na establisyimento ay walang pahintulot na magbukas ngayong MECQ:

1. Dine-in restaurants (tanging delivery at take out lamang ang pinapayagan)
2. Public and Private Constructions na *hindi essential* base sa Annex A ng Memorandum Circular No. 20-44 Series of 2020 ng DTI
3. Barbershops and Salons
4. Lahat ng establisyimentong naghahatid ng personal care and and aesthetic procedures
5. Gyms / Fitness Studios and Sports Facilities
6. Testing and Tutorial Centers
7. Review Centers
8. Internet Cafes / Computer Shops
9. Drive-in cinemas
10. Pet grooming services
11. Language, driving, dance/acting/voice schools
12. Entertainment industries
13. Libraries, archives, museums and cultural centers
14. Tourist destinations (halimbawa: water parks, beaches, resorts)
15. Travel agencies, tour operators, reservation services, and related activities
16. Full-body massage
17. Tattoo and body piercing
18. Live Events

Sumusunod ang mga establisyimento na hindi maaaring magbukas habang nasa ilalim ng anumang klasipikasyong pangkuwarentina ang Lungsod:

1. Traditional cockfighting and operation of cockpits
2. Beerhouses & similar establishments whose primary business is serving alcoholic drinks

3. Kid amusement industries

SEKSYON V. REGULASYON PATUNGKOL SA MGA MALL AT SHOPPING CENTER. Ang mga malls at shopping center ay pinahintulatang magbukas hanggang sa 50% ng kanilang operational capacity lamang. Ang patuloy na pagtalima sa Department of Trade and Industry – Memorandum Circular No. 20 – 21 ay tinatagubilin.

Ang mga may edad 20 pababa at 60 pataas, mga may immunodeficiency, comorbidity, mga nagdadalang-tao, at may mga health risks, ay makapapasok lamang sa mga malls at shopping centers kung sila ay napagkalooban ng quarantine pass- i.e. sila ay walang ibang kasama sa bahay na mayroong home quarantine pass upang makabili ng mga pangunahing pangangailangan.

Tanging mga APOR at ang mga residente ng Malolos na napagkalooban na quarantine pass lamang ang maaaring makapasok sa mga Mall at Shopping Centers.

SEKSYON VI. PAGSASAGAWA NG CONTACT TRACING NG MGA ESTABLISYIMENTO AT TANGGAPAN NGAYONG MECQ; PAGPAPATUPAD NG MINIMUM HEALTH PROTOCOLS. Alinsunod sa Memorandum Circular No. 20-44 Series of 2020 ng Department of Trade and Industry, ang lahat ng establisyimentong may pahintulot na magbukas ay kinakailangan magrehistro sa anumang IATF-endorsed tracing application gaya ng Safepass or StaySafePH or gamit ang contact tracing forms na lakip ng Atas na ito bilang Annex III-1 at Annex III-2.

Gayundin, ang mga establisyimentong bukas ngayong MECQ ay tinatagubilinan na ipatupad ang mga sumusunod:

1. No Mask, no entry policy;
2. No quarantine pass / travel authority, no entry policy;
3. Pagsasagawa ng regular na disinfection na hindi bababa sa isang beses isang linggo;
4. Pagpapatupad ng social distancing;
5. Hindi pagpapapasok ng mga empleyado na mayroong sintomas ng coronavirus;
6. Paglalagay ng alcohol sa mga pasukan ng establisyimento;
7. Hindi pagpapapasok ng mga indibidwal na mayroong temperature na 37.8 pataas;

SEKSYON VII. OPERASYON SA MGA OPISINA NG GOBYERNO. Ang mga opisina ng gobyerno ay maaaring magbigay ng serbisyo gamit ang kanilang skeletal workforce o iba pang alternatibong paraan ng paggampan sa mga tungkulin.

SEKSYON VIII. PAMANTAYAN PATUNGKOL SA MGA MASS GATHERING. Ang Tanging mga pagtitipon na patungkol sa pagbibigay ng kritikal na serbisyo ng pamahalaan at *humanitarian activities* na may pahintulot ng pamahalaang lokal ang maaaring ganapin ngayong MECQ. Ang mga *religious gathering* ay pinahihintulutan sa kondisyong hindi lalagpas sa limang (5) katao lamang ang dadalo. Hindi pinahihintulutan ang mga pagtitipon gaya ng konsiyerto, panunuod ng sine, sporting events, community assemblies at iba pang walang kaugnayan sa pagtupad sa mga gampanin ng mga APOR.

SEKSYON IX. MAHIGPIT NA PAGPAPATUPAD NG ISOLATION NG MGA INDIBIDWAL NA “COVID-19 SUSPECTS”. Ang sinumang matukoy ng Contact Tracing Team ng Lungsod na nagkaroon ng close contact sa isang *COVID-19 patient* at nagpakita ng sintomas ng coronavirus na walang sariling bukod na silid sa kanyang tahanan at natukoy ng mga manggagamot na hindi kailangan ng pagpapaospital ay agarang dadalhin ng Contact Tracing Team ng Lungsod sa isa sa mga *isolated facilities* ng Lungsod.

Ang Kapulisan at ang Tanggapang ng Panlungsod na Manananggol ay maaaring magsampa ng kaukulang kaso sa ilalim ng Republic Act 11332 na mas kilala bilang “Mandatory Reporting of Notifiable Diseases and Health Events of Public Health Concern Act” para sa mga hindi tatalima sa alituntuning ito.

SEKSYON X. PAG-INOM NG ALAK / PAGSUSUGAL. Sa kadahilanang patuloy na tumataas ang bilang ng kaso ng COVID-19 sa Lungsod, pinagbabawal ang pagkonsumo ng anumang inuming nakalalasing. Gayundin, ang pagsusugal ay hindi pinahihintulutan habang ang Lungsod ay nasa ilalim ng *Modified Enhanced Community Quarantine*.

SEKSYON XI. CURFEW. Maliban sa mga APOR at sa mga indibidwal na mayroong travel authority mula sa PNP, mananatili ang curfew mula ika-walo ng gabi hanggang ika-lima ng umaga (8PM-5AM). Ito ay bilang pagbibigay-daan sa mas pinahabang oras ng pagbubukas ng mga establisyemento alinsunod sa IATF Guidelines.

SEKSYON XII. PAGKAKAROON NG QUARANTINE CHECKPOINTS. Muling ipatutupad ang mga checkpoint sa mga borders ng Lungsod. Ang mga Punong Barangay ay inaatasang magpatupad na barangay checkpoint na pangungunahan ng kani-kanilang mga Barangay Tanod. Magkagayunman, nararapat siguruhin na hindi magkakaroon ng hadlang ang mga pagbiyahe o paghahatid ng serbisyo na pinahihintulutan sa mga lugar na nasa ilalim ng MECQ.

SEKSYON XIII. BARANGAY CONTACT TRACING TEAM AT BARANGAY HEALTH EMERGENCY RESPONSE TEAM. Inaatasan ang mga Punong Barangay na magbuo ng Barangay Contact Tracing Team alinsunod sa advisory ng Kagawaran ng Interyor at Pamahalaang Lokal. Kasabay nito, ang mga Barangay Health Emergency Response Team ay nararapat na gawing aktibo upang maging katuwang ng Tanggapan ng Panlungsod na Manggagamot sa pagpapatupad ng mga hakbangin patungo sa pagmomonitor ng mga kaso ng coronavirus at mga katatayuang pangkalusugan ng bawat barangay.


SEKSYON XIV. KAPARUSAHAN. Ang sinumang lalabag sa Atas na ito ay maaaring sampahan ng kaukulang kaso ng Kapulisan o ng Tanggapan ng Panglungsod na Manananggol.

SEKSYON XV. SUGNAY NA NAGBUBUKLOD. Anumang kautusan o polisiya ang ilathala ng Pamahalaang Panlalawigan, lalo’t higit ng Pamahalaang Nasyunal, ay ginagawang bahagi ng Atas na ito.

SEKSYON XVI. SUGNAY NG PAGHIHIWALAY. Sakaling ang alinman sa mga sugnay ng Atas na ito ay maipawalang-bisa, mananatiling may bisa ang lahat ng sugnay na maaaring ihiwalay sa sugnay na nawalan ng bisa.

SEKSYON XVII. KABISAAN. Ang Atas Tagapagpaganap na ito ay maybisa sa sandaling ito ay malagdaan.
